

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS

Entries - Competitions are open to Members of the Association who hold a current 'Active' CONGU handicap. Competitors are requested to apply in writing or use the forms in the Fixture Books or download an application form from the Website. Entry forms must be sent to the Competition Secretary accompanied by a cheque made payable to C.C.L.G.A.

Entries cannot be accepted without Entrance fees. Late entries may be accepted if the timesheet is not full but cannot be accepted for competitions with a draw i.e. Championship, Doris Chambers Cup and Elisabeth Wilson Scratch Shield. If oversubscribed, a ballot will be made, except for the Championship when the highest handicaps will be eliminated. Single entries may be accepted. Money will only be refunded if the organizer is notified more than 48hrs before the competition.

Starting Times - Competitors should report to the starter 5 minutes before their starting time. Failure to start on time is covered by Rule 6-3. The Committee may choose to employ Rule 33-1.

'ACTIVE' CONGU Handicap Certificates - These must be shown on checking in. If not available the player may arrange for a copy to be sent or faxed to the Competition Secretary. This must arrive before the player completes her round (second round in a 36 hole competition). A Competitor out of the handicap limit on the day of the competition may play but must play off the lower handicap.

Score Cards - These are deemed to have been returned when they are posted in the box provided.

Ties - Scratch and Handicap ties shall be decided on the last 9,6,3,1 holes, then over the front 9 holes using the same formula. Ties over 36 holes shall be decided on the last 18,9,6,3,1 holes, then over the 1st 18 holes using the last 9,6,3,1. In the event of a tie continuing, the qualifying place or places will be decided by a sudden death playoff.

Prizes - Competitors may not take more than one prize in the same event – except in Championships. At the Doris Chambers Salver and the Margaret Sangster Salver Meetings the 1st Handicap prize takes precedence over 1st Gross and 1st Gross over 2nd and 3rd Handicap.

Transportation - Except in Championships, a buggy will be allowed in extenuating circumstances on production of a written request and a medical certificate as set down in the E.W.G.A. rules. In this case the partner may not make any use of the buggy. The County will not accept liability for any accident, injury or damage.

Balls - In Championships, balls listed on the R&A. list of conforming balls must be used.

Caddies - Professional golfers may not act as caddies.

Adverse Playing Conditions - Suspension of play will be signalled by a klaxon – see notice on check-in desk for details. The Captain, in consultation with available Committee Members will decide any changes considered necessary to the format. Should a competition be abandoned, the entry fee is non-refundable if a competitor has commenced play.

The Decisions - The decisions of the Executive Committee or Championship Committee will, in all matters, be final.

Disclaimer - The Association cannot be held responsible for any accident which may occur to or be caused by competitors in County Competitions. Players are strongly advised to take out Public Liability Insurance.

Measuring Devices - These are not permitted in Regional and County Competitions in accordance with Rule 14.3.

RULES

Management

1.a The name of the Association shall be “The Cheshire County Ladies Golf Association.”

b. This Association is a non-profit making organization. The Association shall not make a distribution of any surplus save to another non-profit making body or in part or whole to the members on dissolution.

2.The Association shall consist of President, Vice-Presidents, Honorary Members, Members, Associate Members and Individual Members

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Qualification for Membership

3.a Qualification for full or Associate Membership shall be as defined in the County Golf Regulations, issued by E.W.G.A., and are not subject to change by the County Association or its members at a General Meeting. Refer to E.W.G.A. Handbook, County Golf.

b. Individual membership is available to those who are not playing members of a golf club in England affiliated to E.W.G.A.. Individual members must hold a CONGU handicap to be eligible to play in C.C.L.G.A. Competitions.

For County Purposes the “County Home Club” shall be the one at which a player’s CONGU Handicap is maintained. A change of County Home Club should be made at the end of the calendar year (CONGU UHS13.3).

Associate members with CONGU Handicaps maintained outside the County must designate their County Home Club.

Subscription

4. Finance will be raised by a mandatory per capita levy from every playing member of a golf club affiliated to E.W.G.A.. Payment of a per capita levy will entitle her to Full or Associate Membership of the County Association. Each affiliated club shall collect and pay the C.C.L.G.A. by way of annual per capita levy for every member entitled to play golf, exclusive of County Honorary Members, such sum as may be decided by the Executive Committee and approved by the Annual General Meeting.

A list of Members’ names must be included. Individual Members must pay their annual subscription to the Hon. Treasurer by 31st January, such a sum as may be approved by the Annual General Meeting. Resignations must be in writing and should reach the Hon. Secretary or the Membership Secretary by the end of the County year. i.e. 31st January.

Annual Meeting

5. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in November. Fourteen days notice of the meeting shall be sent to each affiliated club for Members' information.

Propositions and Resolutions for the Agenda must reach the Secretary not later than the 31st August. All members present at the meeting are eligible to vote. The election of the Committee Members shall be in three regions, North East, Mid and West Cheshire. The boundaries to be decided by the Executive Committee.

a. Only one vote may be given to each candidate.

b. Each member of the Association shall be entitled to vote for any number of such candidates not exceeding the number of vacancies in the ballot, a member may vote only for representatives in the region of her County Home Club.

Committees

6. Executive Committee.

a. The Committee shall consist of Captain, Immediate Past Captain, Vice Captain, Hon. Treasurer, Training Officer, Junior Organiser and nine Members with voting rights. Also the President, Hon. Secretary, Competition Secretaries, Fixture Secretary, Membership Secretary, L.G.U., E.W.G.A. and E.W.G.A. Northern Division Representatives without a vote.

b. Six shall constitute a quorum.

c. Three members to be elected each year, one from each Region. Members shall be elected to the Committee by ballot at the General Meeting, each affiliated Club having the power to nominate one member of the Association from their club for election, providing the club is not already represented. Members to be elected to the Committee must be nominated from their "County Home Club".

All nominations must be received by the Hon. Secretary not later than the 31st August. Members shall be appointed to the Committee for three years on the expiry of which they must retire for one year. The Executive Committee shall be permitted to co-opt a member to the Executive Committee or to the Selection Committee to fill a vacancy for one year or under. That member can then stand for election the following year if there is a vacancy.

d. The Committee shall arrange all Competitions and fix the dates for all meetings.

e. Committees shall meet when considered desirable by the Captain and the Hon. Secretary, or upon a request in writing signed by any three Members of the Committee.

Election of Divisional Representative

7. Extract from the E.W.G.A. Rules and Regulations (Rule 9a) "Each Divisional Committee shall consist of one Member from each County Association within the Division elected in such a manner as each County Association may respectively decide, provided that all Clubs in the County affiliated to E.W.G.A. or to the L.G.U. are given opportunity to nominate the County Representative to the Divisional Committee."

Selection Committee

8. The Committee shall consist of the Captain, Immediate Past Captain, Vice Captain, and two Members of the County Association to serve for three years. Three shall constitute a quorum.

President

9. The President shall be elected by the previous Presidents and shall serve for two years.

Captain

10. The Captain shall be elected by the last five Captains. The Captain shall take the chair at all meetings. Should both the Captain and the Immediate Past Captain be absent, the Members present shall select a Chairman. The Chairman shall have a casting vote at any meeting.

Alteration of Rules

11. No Rule of the Association may be repealed or altered and no new rule may be made save by a 2/3rd majority of the members present and voting at an AGM or EGM of the Association.

N.B. There will be a transitional period during which our rules will be reviewed to incorporate the E.W.G.A. Modernization Programme . Any necessary amendments to the C.C.L.G.A. rules will be put to the next Annual General Meeting.
